Tips for Completing the Schedule Planner

HUM 110 is required in your first year. Plan to take it with the same instructor in fall and spring.

Plan to take a course or courses that satisfy **Group** <u>Distribution Requirements</u>.

Some majors require that you get started in that department right away. The <u>Advising Handbook</u> has sample schedules to assist with academic planning.

More tips for Completing the Schedule Planner

Some courses have multiple components, such as lectures and labs. Keep track of these separate components/meeting times on your Schedule Planner.

Have second and third choice courses in mind in case classes fill. You can also add yourself to a waitlist.

Plan to take Physical Education classes - they are a degree requirement.
